

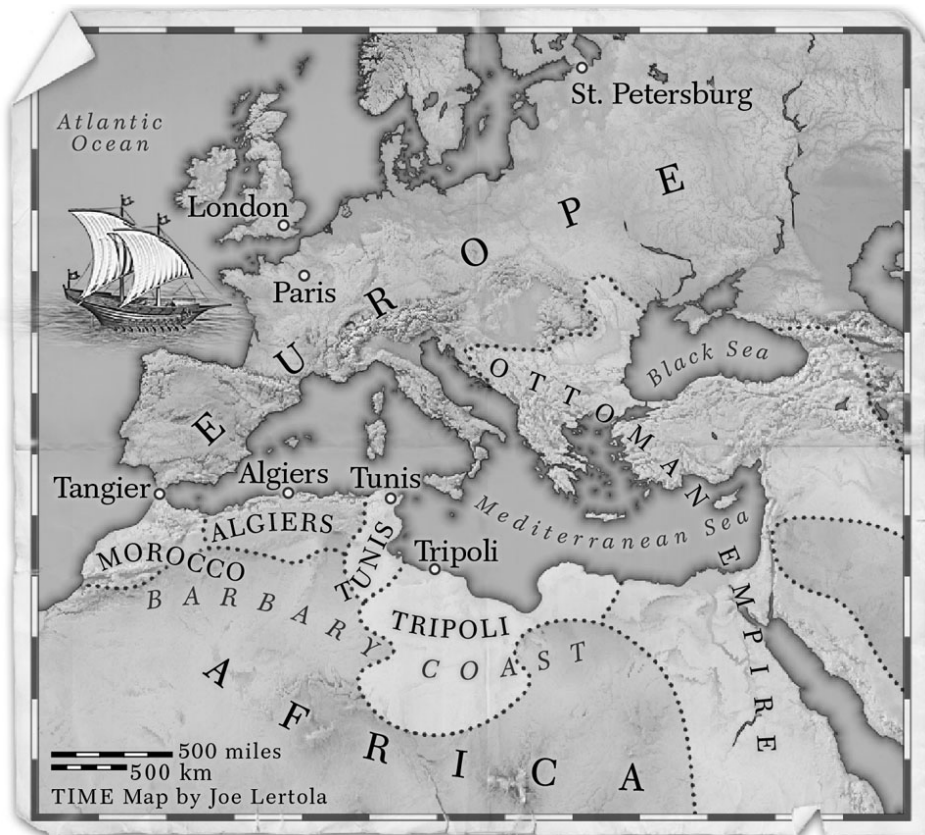

**Americans in Foreign Seas**

By 1800 the (1)\_\_\_\_\_ had almost 1,000 merchant ships trading around the world. When Thomas Jefferson refused to pay more money for protection of American ships in the Mediterranean, the ruler of (2)\_\_\_\_\_ chopped down the flagpole of the American consulate. In 1804 (3)\_\_\_\_\_ slipped into Tripoli Harbor and burned the (4)\_\_\_\_\_ to prevent Barbary pirates from using it.



## Freedom of the Seas

In the war between Great Britain and France, the United States had (5) \_\_\_\_\_, the right to sail the seas and not take sides. In need of sailors, British naval patrols stopped American ships and (6) \_\_\_\_\_ thousands of American citizens into service. When the British attacked the (7) \_\_\_\_\_ in June 1807, many Americans called for war against Great Britain.
